



How to try out the beacons – Android Instructions (Phone and Tablet)

You need an Android phone or Tablet running Android 4.4 or newer. To check your Android version, go to select Apps > Settings > About phone or About tablet (Your Android software version will be listed under 'System Version'). You can also visit www.whatismyandroidversion.com. *Some Android 4.3 phones such as Samsung phones may work well.*

1) Install the Physical Web App:

Either search in the Google Play Store for 'Physical Web'. The icon looks like:



Or Open your phone's browser and go to: http://bit.ly/android_pw
Once in the Google Play store, click 'Install'

2) Launch the Physical Web app by selecting 'Open' or touching the icon from your home screen or app drawer. If you do not have Bluetooth on, the app will ask you to turn it on. You must choose 'Allow' in order for beacon scanning to work.

3) To refresh the list of beacons, pull down on the list of beacons. For now, please don't use the option 'show example beacons' as there are real beacons nearby!

Please go to the 'test beacon' that we've put near the font (towards the back of the church) and refresh the list of beacons – if you can't see the test beacon, something might be wrong!

Now go and explore! There are 13 beacons in total, including the test beacon.

Please try to use your own 3G or 4G data connection. If that doesn't work, we have set up some temporary WiFi hotspots. These are called "GSM Beacons" and the password is "historyworks"



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Use an app like 'Red Laser' to scan these
